



With a shared interest in advancing student-focused, learning-centered higher education, and with a mutual interest in facilitating a seamless transfer of opportunities that support our soldiers in earning a baccalaureate degree, Wayland Baptist University and Cochise College agree and have established a transfer admission and articulation agreement. The agreement will assure that graduates of Cochise College will be admitted to Wayland Baptist University with the number of Cochise College credit hours indicated in the agreement to be applied to the specified Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) degree program(s).

The established Transfer Admission Guarantee program is based on the principle that all Cochise College associate degrees will transfer as a block. Every attempt is made to accept as many hours as possible in transfer. Wayland Baptist University will evaluate each student's work for acceptance and generally agrees to transfer up to 72 lower level hours in our BAS program. Wayland Baptist University will also grant up to 12 upper level credit hours for 4 years of documented full-time work experience, as well as evaluate Joint Service Transcripts for any credit that can possibly be used in the degree program. For each baccalaureate degree program offered by Wayland Baptist University, the service member must have at least 31 Wayland residency hours.

The BAS degree allows the service member to apply vocational/technical field (i.e., courses, training, or work experience) as credit toward a baccalaureate degree. The BAS is an individualized program that is designed to meet the needs of each service member based on the specialization they wish to pursue. Some popular degree in the BAS program are: Intelligence Operations, Cybersecurity, Aviation Operations, Business, and Management.
